President Rosemary Rossiter announced that the University Trustees had approved three new emeriti, welcoming them to the Emeriti Association:




Vice President Scott Moody introduced the speaker for the May meeting, Dr. Donal C. Skinner, Dean of the Honors Tutorial College. Skinner enthusiastically spoke of the history, the current direction and the future priorities for the College. He summarized his own odyssey from the Republic of South Africa to Cambridge, to INRA (Tours, France), to the University of Wyoming, and to Ohio University, emphasizing the benefits of international opportunities for university students. He was joined by Dr. Chris Lewis, Director - Office of Nationally Competitive Awards who reviewed assistance provided to students in the past 3 years resulting in 8 Goldwater Scholarships, 15 Fulbright awards, 12 Critical Language Scholarships and other awards.
