Haning Hall Background and History

- 35 W Union St., Athens Ohio
- 25,766 GSF
 - 2 main floors + Basement
- Built: 1906
- Lot size: 0.5 acres
- Parcel ID: A027230000400
- Auditor's Appraised Value: \$2.11M

- The three-story building was constructed in 1906 as the Athens Post Office.
- Ohio University acquired it in 1964, and in 1965 it was remodeled to provide office space. It has since been home to a variety of academic and administrative departments and was the original site of the university's computer center.
- Haning Hall is named in honor of Harley Hildreth Haning. A native of Athens, he received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Ohio University in 1894. He was a prominent local business figure and served as treasurer of the university from 1906 until his retirement.








Haning Hall Auditor's Parcel






Haning Hall Basement






Haning Hall 1st Floor
