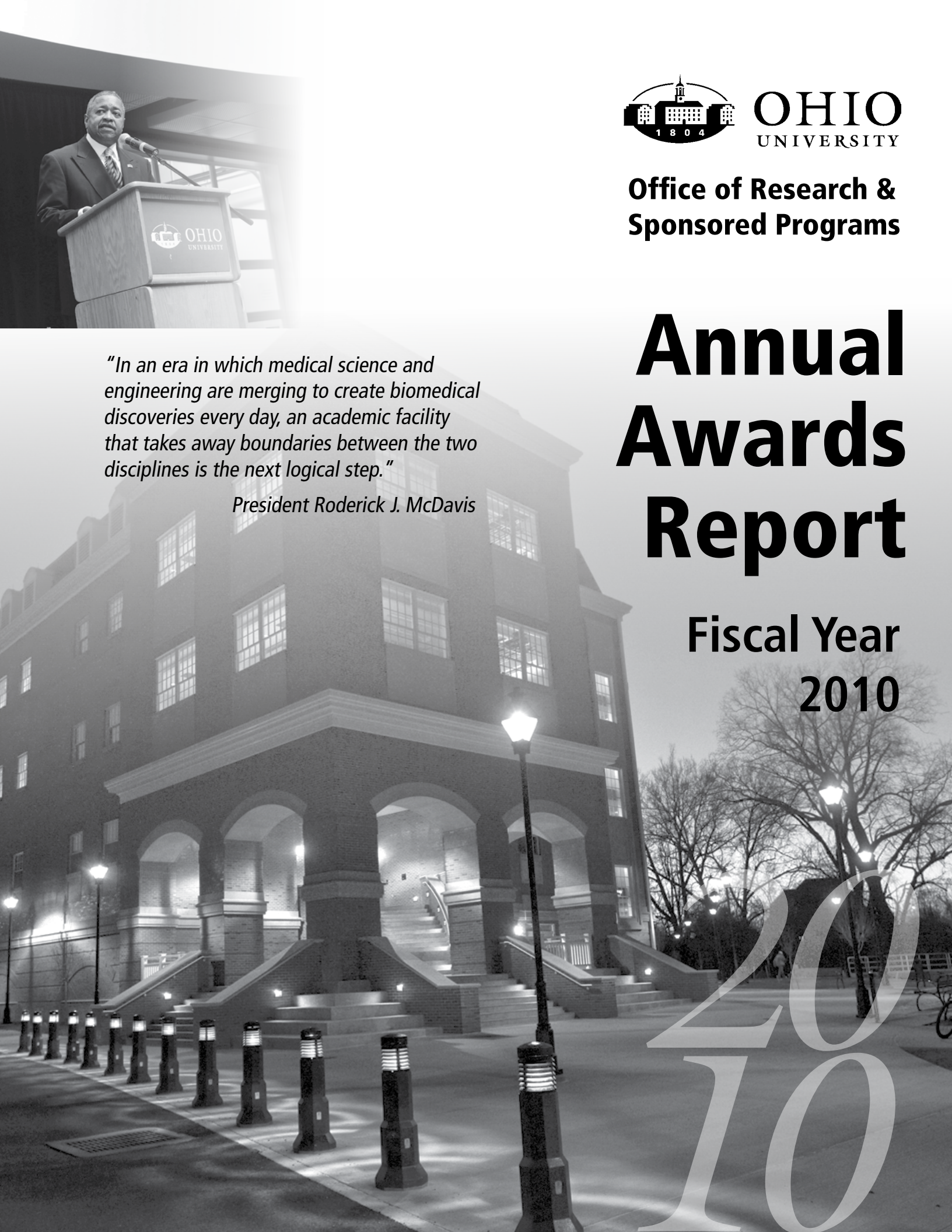

Charles R. and Marilyn Y. Stuckey Academic and Research Center

Ohio University celebrated the grand opening of the Osteopathic Heritage Foundations and Charles R. and Marilyn Y. Stuckey Academic and Research Center May 8, 2010. A facility designed to foster new partnerships between biomedical scientists and engineers in the College of Osteopathic Medicine and the Fritz J. and Dolores H. Russ College of Engineering and Technology. The building connects both Stocker Center and Irvine Hall, making it easy for collaborating researchers to work together. The \$34.5 million ARC building was financed primarily through private donations. The Osteopathic Heritage Foundations contributed \$10 million toward construction, and Board of Trustees member and Russ College alumnus Charles Stuckey and his wife, Marilyn, donated \$5 million.
